

Quality Assurance Intern

JOB DESCRIPTION

Reports To: QA Lead and SVP of Operations

Role: The QA Intern is responsible for assisting in the inspection of products, processes, and to ensure compliance with company/regulatory policies, procedures/specifications and ecommerce industry best practices for software testing

Primary Responsibilities:

- Conduct tests on products and processes to establish functionality and effectiveness
- Determine what code modifications are needed after testing
- Review existing test processes to identify inefficiencies in processing and potential weaknesses
- Develop and plan change implementation
- Observe internal control procedures and evaluate their effectiveness
- Conduct test on platform and individual sites for functional requirements
- Perform tests on bugs associated with software development lifecycle
- Perform tests on platform enhancements
- Document results and observations after inspections and audits
- Manage projects, including departmental and division initiatives

Skill Requirements: Successful candidates will likely have at least 1-2 years of undergraduate studies in computer science or a related field and a strong interest in software development testing and ecommerce

Additional skills include:

- Technological Requirements: C++, SQL, JavaScript, ASP.net, VBScript and jQuery are highly desirable; experience with Selenium, BrowserMob or a similar product for automated test script generation is a plus
- Working knowledge of computer programs including Excel, Power Point, Vizio etc... Experience with Salesforce and comparison shopping engines is a plus
- Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts, draw valid conclusions and provide solutions
- Interprets a variety of technical information; experience with manual testing
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills; precise attention to detail
